

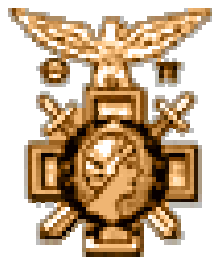

Ottawa AHEPA/Daughter of Penelope Scholarship

The AHEPA's Family commitment to education has been well documented throughout its history. The Ottawa chapters of AHEPA and the Daughters of Penelope provides two (\$500.00) scholarships each calendar year. The first scholarship is awarded to a graduating high school student who is continuing his/her education at a university or community college. The second scholarship is awarded to a person continuing his/her undergraduate studies at a university of community college. Below are the eligibility requirements, rules and regulations pertaining to both scholarships.

Eligibility Criteria/Requirements

Applicant must be a student of Greek descent, graduating high school senior and planning to attend an accredited college or university, or currently an undergraduate or graduate student continuing his/her studies in an accredited college or university.

Please be sure to supply the following – Applicant Checklist:

- **An original transcript of final marks or a certified true copy from High School/University. Photocopies will not be accepted**
- **If entering university from high school, proof of acceptance and pre-registration to university enrolment for Fall 2009 in a full-time capacity**
- **Two(2) reference letters including names and phone numbers**
- **A 200 word essay stating your vocational and personal goals in life, as well as your involvement in the community.**

Submitted applications that do not fulfill all the above rules and requirements will not be considered.
